

Avaada Foundation Donates Garbage Collection Vehicle to Adhoi Municipal Corporation, Kutch

The donated vehicle—a Tata Ace Gold Petrol Van equipped with a hydraulic tipper—is specially designed for door-to-door garbage collection. Built on a TATA ACE B6 cabin chassis, the van features A 2.0 m³ bucket capacity, two compartments for wet and dry waste segregation, four openable windows with a durable MS sheet covering.
