Avaada Foundation is proud to contribute to the educational development of tribal and remote communities by providing two 42-seater school buses in Madhya Pradesh. These buses serve a crucial role in ensuring that education is accessible to students who otherwise face significant barrier.

- Betul District: 543 tribal students from 18 villages in Jamethi now have safe and reliable transportation to attend their primary and secondary schools.
- Ujjain District: 550 boys and girls from Mahidpur can now regularly attend their primary and middle schools thanks to these services.

This initiative goes beyond transportation; it directly enhances school attendance, encourages better academic performance, and motivates parents to prioritize their children's education. By reducing the challenges of distance, we are not just providing a means to attend school, but we are also empowering an entire generation, helping them pursue a brighter future.
